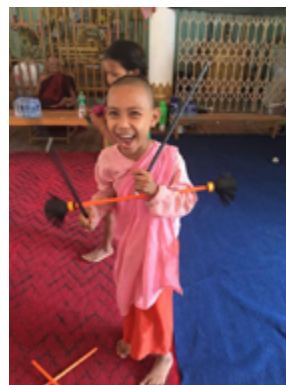
We are crowdfunding now for our 2019-20 season: our 6th year of social circus in Myanmar. We need your support and donations to continue the project: please help.



Social Circus Myanmar is a small not-for-profit group based in Yangon, Myanmar (Burma).

We use social circus as an engagement tool for the social and personal development of children, youth and young adults.

The children and young people we engage with are disadvantaged, marginalised; some live with disabilities - we use play, circus-skills and theatre games to help them develop their skills, abilities and confidence.



We have been working Myanmar since 2014, from November to March each year.
